SAFER SOUTHGATE

Cllr Charith Gunawardena has written to Superintendent Chris Jones of the Metropolitan Police Service (Partnerships & Neighbourhoods) asking for more officer resources for the Southgate Ward.

Police numbers across London have fallen sharply from the pre-austerity period.

Local residents continue to raise issues related to burglary, robbery, person theft, motor theft, criminal damage, domestic violence, anti-social behaviour, drug related crime across Southgate.

Charith stated "I am committed to supporting local community volunteer groups that are now assisting local police officers who are shouldering the burden of keeping Southgate ward safe." ●
